Internet	No physical space to rent or maintain	technical obstacles, not face to face relationships

3rd worship service at current site	no additional costs	additional logistics	
The Loft	close to campus, could help IV with rent, could be used throughout the week as a hangout spot, close to parking garage	Not very accessible/attractive to community people

Another Church	"Church" atmosphere	Would have to work around their schedule	
<b>Criteria deemed important in choosing a 2nd site location</b>			
	It must be accessible to students (ie close to campus)		
	It must be available to congregation throughout the week		
<b>Other important considerations when implementing a 2nd site</b>			
	The whole church (leadership, young, old) must be behind it		
	You must first have a heart for those you wish to reach		

	You must acknowledge God will make it work, not by all the work you put into it	
	Prayer should be the number one priority in deciding where to locate	
	Growth will not occur just because you have the space, but as a result of personal initiatives to invite people.
